Regular **MINUTES** City Council Meeting 7pm, June 24, 2025

Regular City Council Meeting of Pioneer Village held at City Hall 4700 Summitt Drive Louisville, KY 40229.
Mayor Gary Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7pm on June 24, 2025.

Council Members present: Peggy Druin, Dorleen Garrett, John Mast, James Burke, and Don Howell. Absent Shane Nichols.
Also, in attendance: City Attorney Mark Edison, City Clerk Micheale McCauley, and the Pioneer News Media absent.

Invocation by: Chaplain, Joe Wells All recited the Pledge of Allegiance

- ✚ City Clerk McCauley read the regular meeting minutes from May 27, 2025. Don Howell made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes as read. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Jim Burke made a motion to accept the financial report from May 31, 2025. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

- ✚ Attorney Edison read the 1st reading Ordinance 2025-03 Real Property AdVal Taxes.
- ✚ Attorney Edison read the 1st reading Ordinance 2025-04 Personal Property AdVal Taxes.
- ✚ Attorney Edison read the 1st reading Ordinance 2025-05 Public Service Co AdVal Taxes. Attorney Edison said the Personal Property and PSC Taxes must be the same rate.
- ✚ The Mayor asked the Council to surplus a salt spreader and 1999 Ford F150 to sell on GovDeals. Peggy Druin made a motion to surplus the salt spreader and 1999 Ford F150. Jim Burke 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Jim Burke made a motion to amend the current agenda to add two items in new business. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ The Mayor reported that the community garden club would like to add a temporary wooden 9' x 17' lean-to with a roof and a rain tank. Jim Burke made a motion to allow the community garden club to build a 9' x 17' wooden lean-to with a roof. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Peggy Druin asked the Council to purchase 2 double-sided message boards for the Walk Park for \$3603.06 from Kirby Built. Don Howell made a motion for the City to purchase 2 double-sided message boards for the Walk Park for \$3603.06 from Kirby Built. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

- ✚ The Mayor reported on 6/19/25 the City closed on the Rager property behind City Hall (Lot 74 Sec 2) which will connect the Walk Park to Old Pioneer Village.

- ✚ The Mayor reported the second dog waste station was installed on the back side of the Walk Park by Jim Burke and John Fries.
- ✚ Don Howell reported he has received all positive feedback on the look of the Walk Park, the pavilion, the American Flags and the community garden.
- ✚ Jim Burke asked if the City could send out an updated Summer Newsletter. The Clerk will get it together with the input from the Council.
- ✚ Dorleen Garrett reported she has also received positive feedback on the Walk Park being a peaceful walk park.

POLICE BUSINESS

- ✚ The police run report for May included 357 calls for Service to Pioneer Village Police Dept.
 - PV 272 calls – 76% Hebron Estates 68 calls – 19% Other 17 calls – 5%
- ✚ The Chief's reported an increase in the number of calls in the City from last month which includes an increase in patrols, code enforcement, traffic control and traffic stops.
- ✚ The Chief reported that Louisville Metro Police Department donated 8 Taser7's to the Pioneer Village Police Department. This is approximately a \$22,000 saving and this donation will keep the City up to date for the next several years.

PLANNING AND ZONING

- ✚ Absent no report.

PUBLIC BUSINESS

- ✚ Christine Rosson asked how the departure of Pioneer Village from Hebron Estates Policing will effect the City. The Mayor said the police activity will increase significantly in the City.
- ✚ Christine Rosson also asked the Mayor if the City could trim the trees on the right side just past Linda's Place to the Hebron Woods entrance.

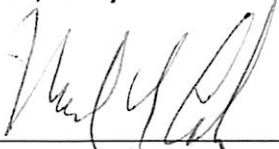
ADJOURNMENT
